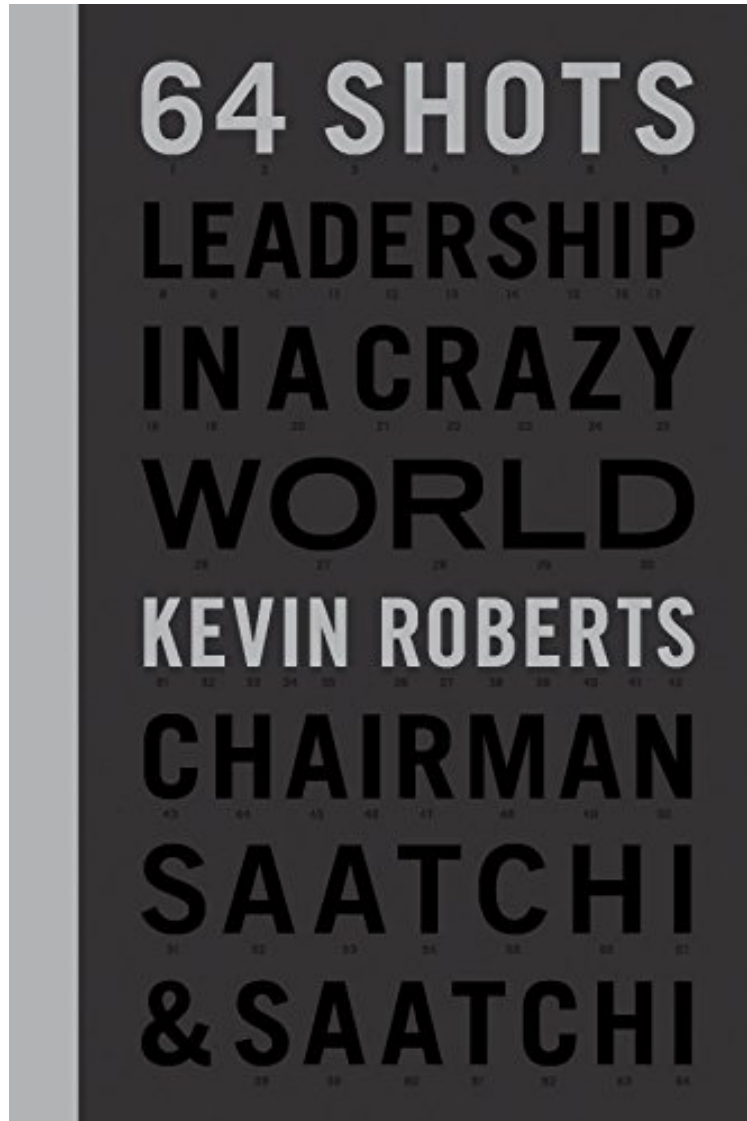

It's my anecdotal observation that when something is wrapped it's either to protect it or keep you from looking at it before buying it. I favor books like 64 shots for their short pieces and observations that I can pick up

and put down in short bursts without losing the flow of a longer piece that can't be read in a single sitting. Too, I always favor a book that has several take aways that I can put to use immediately. 64 shots is that kind of book. Now, I would have likely given it five stars if it didn't include 60 pages of black and white portraits in the middle. I buy nonfiction business books for content and not for photographs. As a hobbyist photographer the images contained in the book are excellent but I buy photography books to fuel that passion. 60 pages of photos no matter how well done in a nonfiction business book is novel but not really value added for me. Your mileage may vary of course.
