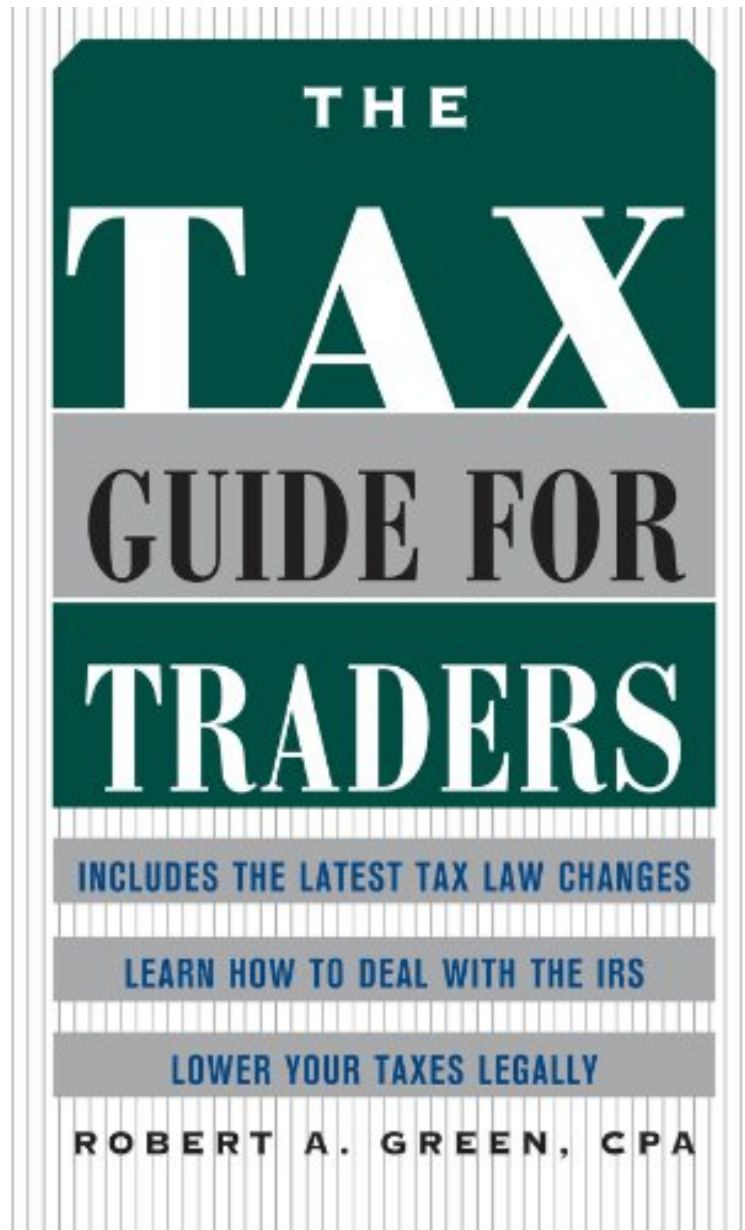

fully explains the IRS designation of "Trader Status" which once achieved grants the trader several tax advantages and benefits. But achieving Trader Status in the eyes of the IRS is quite difficult to do and very few traders actually do achieve it. So Green also goes into legal ways to enjoy most of the benefits of Trader Status by setting up an entity (e.g. an LLC) and trading through that entity. Thoroughly researched it answers the big questions that every trader and aspiring trader needs to know to protect his or her business.
