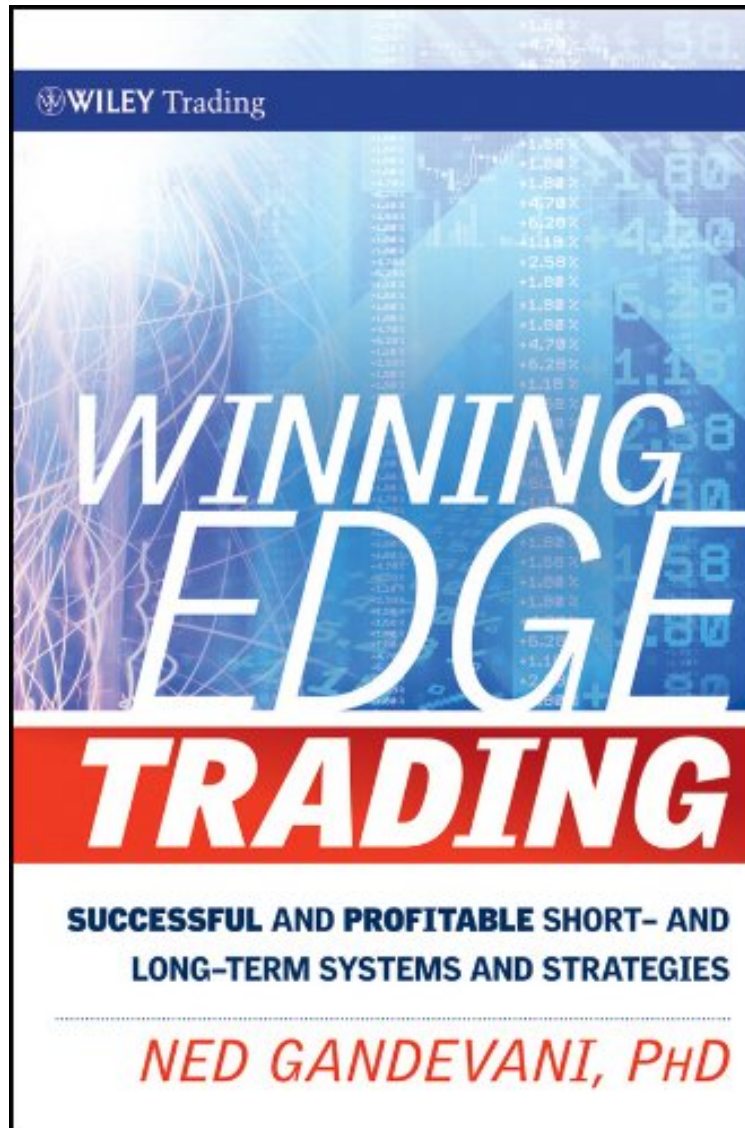

By no means am I an expert trader, but I am no novice either. The information presented in this book is simply not worth reading. To start the author does a decent job discussing generally market theory, which I did find interesting and informative, but not "actionable". The trading strategies outlined in this book are not backed with any quantitative results. Furthermore, these strategies are not presented in a clear manner (i.e. his entry/exits are not well outlined and are extremely subjective). In my opinion the DPO/RSI strategy outlined in this book has almost no real practical application. I bought this book under the pretense of perhaps gaining some further insight into a new/different trading system/strategies, and I must say I that I'm very disappointed. Also, I find that the language in which the book is written is very confusing not because it's advanced, but because I believe him to have poor command of the English language. Additionally, there are grammatical/technical errors throughout the book, but more specifically when he describes the entry/exits for his outlined strategies. This book could be a decent buy for a very novice trader who is looking to learn the basics of systems strategies, but I honestly feel your money would be better spent on another book.
