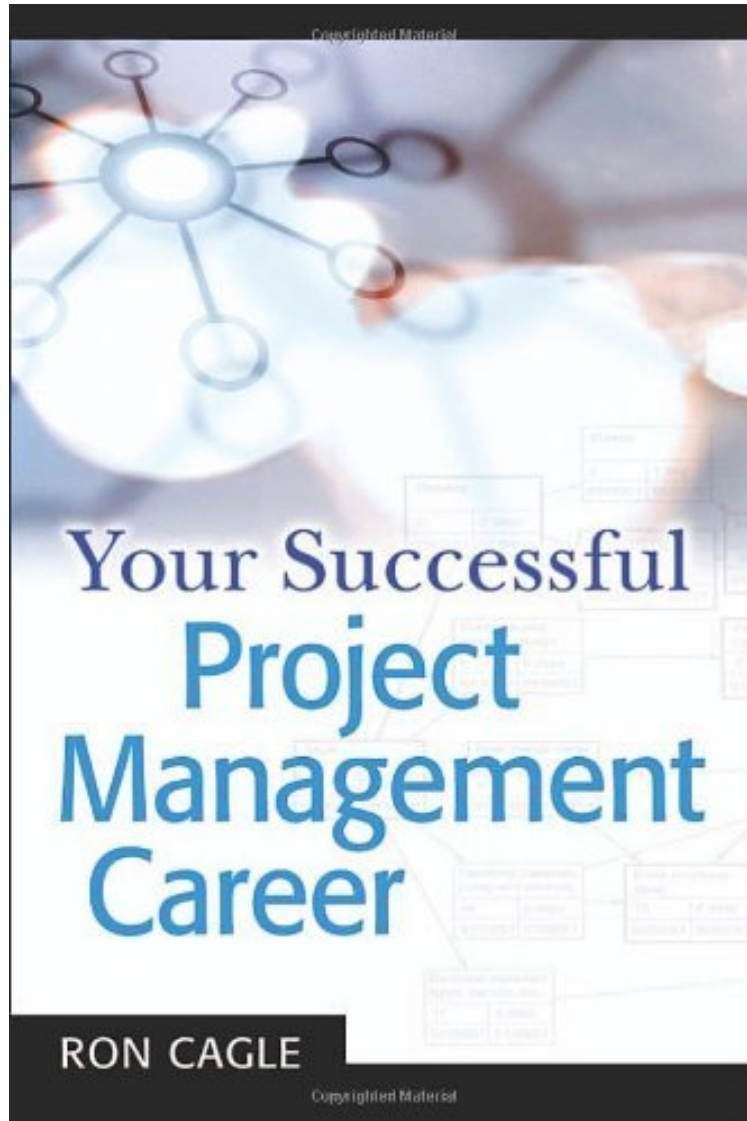

By Wayne Mr. Cagle is an excellent writer and there is plenty to be gained from reading this book, but you'll have to bear with his private definitions. Unlike any of my PM colleagues, any PM article I have ever read, any PM textbook I have ever studied, Mr. Cagle insists on his own definition of the distinction between projects and programs. To him, a project is an internal undertaking while a program is outsourced. What? This new, extremely untidy definition would make all the contracting construction project managers to be called program managers. That'll go over like a lead balloon. PMI has this right. Why promote such a skew perception?

"Your Successful Project Management Career" answers all the questions new project managers typically have, giving them advice and information about entering and excelling in the field.
